The service also offers connections to a wide range of essential resources, including:

- Home Maintenance: Reliable local gardeners, plumbers, cleaners, and pest control.
- Professional Advice: Direct links to Citizens Advice and Mole Valley District Council.
- Health & Social Care: Access to Social Services, Adult Social Care, local health centres and pharmacies.
- Wellbeing & Community: Information on local wellbeing groups, community fridges and the many charitable organisations operating in the district.
