## Railway Improvement Work: Ashtead - Track renewal and level crossing closure

Further to our previous notice, this is a reminder that we'll be returning to carry out essential track renewal (replacement) works to the railway near your property to improve the reliability of the railway in the Ashtead area. The work will take place on 3 individual night shifts from **Wednesday 7 to Friday 9 May 2025.** We're incredibly grateful for your continued cooperation.

We'll be replacing rails and sleepers adjacent to Ashtead station and through Ashtead level crossing with the main works taking place over 3 midweek night shifts of **7**, **8 and 9 May 2025.** 

During these 3 midweek night shifts, it will be necessary to close the level crossing at certain times due to engineering trains and machinery movement at the crossing to keep our teams safe. We'll provide vehicle access to residents across the crossing as outlined below. We will also have a residents assistance plan and an emergency services response plan in place throughout night shifts.

The level crossing closure times are detailed in the table above. The pedestrian diversion routes will be via Ashtead station footbridge and the cattle-creep underpass.
