

What we are doing

We will be installing a new retaining wall on Kingston Road, Leatherhead.



Works area: Parking restrictions:

We will be working on Kingston Road, Leatherhead from the junction with Buffers Lane to the Railway bridge. Access will also be required along the lower Kingston Road.

During these works, you may experience delays. Temporary traffic lights will manage the traffic from the 10 July for approx. 2 weeks between 10.00am to 4.00pm.

Kingston Road will then be closed from the 24 July for approx. 6 weeks while we carry out these works.

From the 1 September for approx. 3 weeks the traffic will be managed by temporary traffic lights between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm.

Access to your properties will be maintained during the work when it is safe to do so, however there will be parking restrictions in place for a significant period of the works. Please speak to a member of staff on site regarding access requirements and they will be able to assist you further.
